Your Information. Your Rights. Our Responsibilities.

This notice describes how medical information about you may be used and disclosed and how you can get access to this information. Please review it carefully. You may request a copy.

Your Rights: You have the right to:

- Get a copy of your paper or electronic record
- Correct your paper or electronic record
- Request confidential communication
- Ask us to limit the information we share – we never market or sell personal information
- Get a list of those whom we have shared your information
- Get a copy of this privacy notice
- Choose someone to act for you
- File a complaint if you believe your privacy right have been violated

Your Choices: You have some choices in how we use and share information as we:

- Tell family and friends about your condition
- Provide disaster relief
- Include you in a hospital directory
- Provide mental health care
- Raise funds

Our Uses and Disclosures: We may use and share your information as we:

- Treat you
- Run our organization
- Bill for our services
- Help with public health and safety issues
- Do research
- Comply with the law
- Respond to organ and tissue donation requests
- Work with a medical examiner or funeral director
- Address worker's compensation, law enforcement and other government requests
- Respond to lawsuits and legal actions
